

Export Inspection Council

- Established by the GOI under the Export (Quality Control & Inspection) Act, 1963
- Main Objective Sound development of export trade through quality control & inspection
- Strength: Official certification body having no conflict of interest

Export (Quality Control & Inspection) Act, 1963 at a glance



- Powers to EIC under the Act.
 - to notify the commodities
 - To specify the type of quality control
 - To establish / adopt or recognize one or more standards.
 - To prohibit the export


Three tier surveillance system

- 1) Monitoring by EIA officials (Frequency / review / areas of monitoring)
- 2) Supervisory visit (DD/6 months)
- 3) Corporate audit (2 officials /once a year / exam. Of records/visit to 5% plants

EU Regulation

- Regulation :
 - Control on primary production
 - Aquaculture farms GAP, Traceability, Procure from registered hatchery
 - Fishing vessels Minimum infra requirement,
 Trace ability
 - Landing sites Minimum infra requirement, Trace ability, Temperature abuse
 - Prohibition of banned antibiotics
 - Group A- Prohibited
 - Group B within MRL

Impact of EU Regulation

- Sampling frequency 50 % sampling -2016/1774 dated 4th October 2016
- Delisting of establishments
 - 14 establishments delisted
 - 18 consignments
 - 1 destroyed
 - 17 returned & tested by EIC- 3 satisfactory
- New listing is suspended
- Scope modification is suspended (PP to PPa)

Way forward

- Sourcing the raw material from the own farms
- If contracted farm then Strict surveillance is required by the establishment
- Controls on Aquaculture Farms
 - Healthy seeds hatcheries need to be monitored
 - Clean water
 - Less population in the pond
 - Availability of permitted drugs (Tetracycline, Oxtetracycline, Trimethoprim, Oxolinic acid) withdrawal period
- Additional Check on EU exports from 18th September 2017
 - Sampling by EIA officials
 - Testing at EIA lab
- In 2019 only 4 RASFF (3 AOZ, 1 CAP) were generated.

Export to P R China

Regulation :

- Related to Viruses: White spot syndrome virus (WSSV) and Infectious hypodermal and hematopoietic necrosis virus (IHHNV)
- Listing on GACC website Listing takes longer time change of requirement of type of information

Impact

- 10 establishments suspended
- 11 consignments
- These establishments are delisted by China
- GACC want EIC to amend the HC stating that the consignments are free from viruses.
- Investigation is in progress / matter is being taken up with The General Administration of Customs of the People's Republic of China (GACC) as similar condition exits in China.

Export to Saudi Arabia

- Regulation
 - Requirement of Self audit report to SFDA
 - Requirement of hard copy instead of electronic communication
- Impact
 - Crustacean is temperedly suspended – Virus issue
 - Listing is delayed

Export to Vietnam

- Dossier in 2 appendix
- 420 establishments are listed
- Many queries are asked by Dept. of Anima health
 - Fishing vessels
 - Landing site
 - Farms
- HACCP should address these issues
